Catch Title: State institution revenue accounts.

Subject: Addresses use and disposition of revenues generated by certain state institutions.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Previously, Wyoming Statutes provided that all monies collected or received by a state institution would be deposited into the state treasury (essentially the general fund). There were provisions contained in general appropriation bills which created certain state institution revenue accounts.
- This act provides the Legislature with the authority to create revenue accounts for funds received or collected by a state institution.
- The act specifically creates special revenue accounts for the Wyoming State Hospital and the Wyoming Retirement Center, and specifies the manner in which funds from these accounts may be expended.

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
