Catch Title: CHIP-program amendments.

Subject: Child Health Insurance Program managed care requirement.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill responds to new federal law mandates by requiring that benefits in the Child Health Insurance Program (CHIP) include managed care to the same extent managed care is provided in the Wyoming Medicaid program.
- The managed care requirement is applicable only if CHIP is provided through a private insurance company licensed by the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to write insurance in Wyoming.

Comments:

- This bill is effective March 31, 2018.
