Catch Title: Autocycles.

Subject: Providing for regulation, registration and licensure of autocycles.

Summary/Major Elements:

- An autocycle is a three wheeled motor vehicle with two wheels in the front, fully or partially enclosed, and with automotive controls and safety belts. Prior to the passage of this bill, Wyoming statutes did not clearly regulate autocycles because an autocycle is both like a car with its seats, safety belts and steering wheel, and like a motorcycle with the single back wheel and smaller size.
- This bill defines an autocycle and specifies requirements for autocycle licensure, registration and necessary equipment.
- Autocycles must follow the rules of the road, including remaining in their lane of traffic and, when overtaking, to do so in the left lane. Only one autocycle may be driven per lane of traffic. This is unlike the law for motorcycles, which may be driven two abreast.
- A person with a class "C" license may operate an autocycle.

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
