Catch Title: Food freedom act-sales locations.

Subject: Food freedom act – sales of homemade food at retail spaces.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill specifies that homemade food may be sold through a retail space at the ranch, farm or home where the food is produced if the retail space informs the end consumer that the homemade food has not been inspected and a sign is displayed indicating that the homemade food has not been inspected.
- If the retail space is in any way associated with a commercial food establishment or offers for sale any inspected product, the retail space selling homemade food shall be separate from the commercial food establishment pursuant to rule and regulation of the Department of Agriculture.

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
