Catch Title: Sexual assault-school employee.

Subject: Creating an offense for sexual assault when an employee or volunteer of a school has sexual contact with a student.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act seeks to close a gap in Wyoming sexual assault statutes by prohibiting employees or volunteers of elementary and secondary schools, whether public or private, from engaging in sexual activity with a student or other participant in the school's activities.
- This act criminalizes sexual contact between an employee who is at least four years older than the student and who has interaction with the student due to the employment or volunteer relationship with the school.
- This new offense is classified as a sexual assault of the second degree if the actor inflicts sexual intrusion on the victim or inflicts sexual contact and causes serious bodily injury.
- This new offense is classified as a sexual assault of the third degree if the actor inflicts sexual contact on the victim without intrusion and without causing serious bodily injury.
