Catch Title: Energy science stipends and fellowships.

Subject: Extending energy science stipends and fellowships.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under the 2011 general government appropriations bill, Abandoned Mine Land (AML) funds appropriated to the University of Wyoming for energy science stipends and fellowships are set to revert on June 30, 2018.
- This bill reappropriates those funds to the University of Wyoming for energy science stipends and fellowships and specifies the appropriation shall not revert until June 30, 2020.
- This bill also requires the University of Wyoming to award at least fifty percent (50%) of the funds awarded each year to qualifying student who are Wyoming residents or who are graduates of the University of Wyoming.

Comments:

- This bill requires a report to the Joint Appropriations Committee, the Joint Minerals, Business and Economic Development Interim Committee and the Governor by November 1 of each year the appropriation is in effect.
