Catch Title: Certified public accountants-amendments.

Subject: Certified public accountant examination.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill amends Wyoming law specifying who may take the examination to be a certified public accountant.
- Current law authorizes candidates to take the examination if they have met certain education requirements, or if they expect to meet those requirements within ninety days following the examination.
- This bill provides that candidates may take the examination if they have completed a baccalaureate or higher degree with an accounting concentration from a college or university approved by the Wyoming Board of Certified Public Accountants (Board).
- The bill requires the Board to determine, through its rules and regulations, which educational programs will be considered sufficient as prerequisites for taking the examination.
