Catch Title: Sex offender registration-accessories.

Subject: Individuals convicted of accessory before the fact for a sex offense.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Under current law, an individual convicted as an accessory before the fact for a sex offender registry offense is not required to register as a sex offender.
- This bill amends the definition of "offender" for purposes of sex offender registration to include persons convicted as an accessory before the fact for a criminal offense for which registration is required. By defining "offender" to include accessories, the bill requires those offenders to:
 - Register with the sheriff of the county the offender resides in;
 - Provide notice to the sheriff of a change of address;
 - Provide information to the sheriff regarding change in employment or enrollment status at an education institution;
 - Provide information to the sheriff regarding any changes, modifications or other information necessary to keep registration information current; and
 - Provide notice to the sheriff of travel outside of the United States.
