Catch Title: Bar and grill liquor license increase.

Subject: Increasing the number of bar and grill licenses available for municipalities.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The bill increases the number of bar and grill licenses authorized for municipalities as follows:
 - For incorporated cities of populations between 7,501 and 20,000, the number of authorized licenses increases from three to six. The previous population range was from 7,501 to 15,000;
 - For incorporated cities of populations between 20,001 and 30,000, the number of authorized licenses increases from four to ten. The previous population range was from 15,001 to 27,500; and
 - For incorporated cities of populations over 30,000, one license is authorized per additional 7,500 people. Previously, for incorporated cities of populations over 27,500, one license was authorized per additional 7,500.
