**"1-15-505. Service of writ; notice to judgment debtor in
continuing garnishment; payment to clerk of court.**

(a) The judgment creditor shall serve two (2) copies of
the writ of continuing garnishment upon the garnishee, one (1)
copy of which the garnishee shall deliver to the judgment debtor
as provided in W.S. 1-15-506. The writ shall be served on the
garnishee in the same manner as a summons under Rule 4(d) of the
Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure or by certified mail sent to
the garnishee at the address of its principal place of business
in accordance with Rule ~~4(1)~~4(r) of the Wyoming Rules of Civil
Procedure. The writ shall include notice to the judgment debtor
of the formula used to calculate:

3-1-111. Complaint against guardian or conservator.

(b) The clerk shall immediately send a copy of the
complaint report to the guardian or conservator in the manner
provided for service of process under Rule ~~4(1)(2)~~4(r)(2) of
the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure."

money.**

(g) Unclaimed prize money shall not constitute net ~~lottery~~
proceeds. A portion of unclaimed prize money, not to exceed two
hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) annually, shall be used
by the corporation to develop, in consultation with the
department of health programs for the treatment of compulsive
gambling disorder and educational programs related to the
disorder. In addition, unclaimed prize money may be added to

1 the pool from which future prizes are to be awarded or used for

11 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than five
12 dollars (\$5.00) nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), and
13 for each subsequent offense the fine shall not be less than
14 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars
15 (\$100.00).".

21 (g) In all contested cases the taking of depositions and
22 discovery shall be available to the parties in accordance with
23 the provisions of Rules 26, 28 through 37 (excepting Rule
24 37(b) (1) and ~~37(b) (2) (D)~~37(b) (2) (A) (vii) therefrom) of the
25 Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure in effect on the date of the
26 enactment of this act and any subsequent rule amendments
27 thereto. All references therein to the "court" shall be deemed
28 to refer to the appropriate "agency"; all references to the use
29 of the subpoena power shall be references to subsection (c) of
30 this section; all references to "trial" shall be deemed
