15 "(f) The department shall adopt rules according to this
16 subsection prescribing the permissible operating time and other
17 requirements of motor carrier drivers and equipment standards
18 that allow specified motor carrier drivers in Wyoming to
19 complete paper records of duty status and that do not require
20 electronic logging devices (ELDs), notwithstanding requirements
21 to make rules consistent with United States department of
22 transportation rules and regulations as provided in subsections
23 (a) and (c) of this section. A motor carrier driver operating in
24 Wyoming and complying with department rules shall comprise
25 substantial compliance with federal requirements. Department
26 rules shall:
27
28 (i) Apply to motor carrier drivers of commercial
29 motor vehicles, as defined in 49 CFR 390.5, within the state of
30 Wyoming not participating in interstate commerce who are
31 required to keep records of duty status;
32
33 (ii) Apply to livestock and agriculture commodity
34 haulers within the state of Wyoming hauling their own goods or
35 participating in sanctioned rodeo, horse racing or fair events;
36
37 (iii) Apply to drivers within the state of Wyoming
38 who use paper logs no more than eight (8) days during any thirty
39 (30) day period or no more than ninety-six (96) days during any
40 calendar year;

42 (iv) Apply to driveaway-towaway drivers within the
43 state of Wyoming transporting a vehicle for sale, lease or
44 repair;

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2 (v) Apply to drivers within the state of Wyoming of
3 vehicles manufactured or containing components manufactured
4 before model year 2000;

5
6 (vi) Specify that nonuse of an ELD shall not
7 invalidate any other safety inspections; and

8
9 (vii) Not prevent an individual or business entity of
10 any kind from voluntarily complying with federal laws involving
11 electronic logging devices.

12
13 (g) No officer, as defined in W.S. 31-5-102(a)(xxiii) and
14 31-1-203(a), shall enforce any rule or regulation in Wyoming for
15 permissible operating time and equipment standards except as
16 provided in subsection (f) of this section and department rules
17 promulgated according to subsection (f) of this section."
