A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to bingo and pull tab game events;
2 providing for local control over bingo and pull tab game
3 events as specified; authorizing fees; making conforming
4 amendments; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-13-101 and 16-13-102 are created

BINGO AND PULL TAB GAME EVENTS

14 **16-13-101. Definitions.**

15

1 (a) As used in this chapter:

2

3 (i) "Charitable or nonprofit organization" means
4 as defined in W.S. 6-7-101(a)(xi);

5

6 (ii) "Governing body" means the board of county
7 commissioners of a county or the governing body of a city
8 or town;

9

10 (iii) "Ordinance" means an ordinance, resolution
11 or other proceeding by which a governing body takes formal
12 action and adopts legislative provisions and matters of
13 some permanency;

14

15 (iv) "Pull tab game event" means an event at
16 which a player purchases a pull tab game piece that is made
17 of paper or paper products with concealed numbers or
18 symbols that the player must expose, often by tearing off a
19 covering tab, to determine wins or losses. "Pull tab game"
20 includes charitable gaming tickets, break opens, banded
21 tickets, jar tickets, tip tickets, pickle cards, instant
22 bingo tickets and other names designated by manufacturers,
23 distributors, players or ordinances of the governing body.

2 **16-13-102. Bingo and pull tab game events; permits;**
3 **fees.**

4

5 (a) No person shall conduct any bingo game or pull
6 tab game event within the boundaries of a governing body's
7 jurisdiction without first obtaining a permit if required
8 by the governing body in accordance with this section.

9

10 (b) A governing body may, by ordinance, authorize the
11 conduct of bingo games and pull tab game events within the
12 boundaries of the governing body's jurisdiction. The
13 ordinance shall:

14

15 (i) Specify the procedure and any requirements,
16 including reasonable fees, for applying for a permit if
17 required by the governing body;

18

19 (ii) Authorize only bingo games and pull tab
20 game events conducted by a charitable or nonprofit
21 organization that has been in existence in this state for
22 at least three (3) years;

23

1 (iii) Require players of bingo and pull tab
2 games to be eighteen (18) years of age or older;

3

4 (iv) Require that bingo cards and tickets and
5 pull tab games are sold only on the premises owned or
6 occupied by the charitable or nonprofit organization;

7

8 (v) Require a charitable or nonprofit
9 organization, in conducting bingo games and pull tab game
10 events, to use only volunteers who are bona fide members of
11 the organization or employees or contractors who are paid
12 by the organization to assist in the operation of the games
13 and events;

14

15 (vi) Require at least fifty percent (50%) of all
16 gross sales of a bingo game or pull tab game event to be
17 redeemed as winnings each month. The net proceeds after
18 payment of winnings shall be restricted as follows:

19

20 (A) No more than forty percent (40%) of net
21 proceeds shall be paid to distributors or manufacturers of
22 supplies or equipment necessary to conduct the event; and

23

1 (B) The organization shall donate annually
2 at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the net proceeds
3 remaining after payment for all costs and supplies to a
4 bona fide charitable or benevolent purpose.

5
6 (vii) Authorize the charitable or nonprofit
7 organization conducting the bingo game or pull tab game to
8 purchase supplies or equipment necessary to conduct the
9 game from a distributor or manufacturer at a price based on
10 a per card or per pull tab basis subject to the limitations
11 provided in subparagraph (vi)(A) of this subsection.

13 **Section 2.** W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iii)(D)(intro) is amended
14 to read:

16 **6-7-101. Definitions.**

18 (a) As used in this article:

19
20 (iii) "Gambling" means risking any property for
21 gain contingent in whole or in part upon lot, chance, the
22 operation of a gambling device or the happening or outcome
23 of an event, including a sporting event, over which the

1 person taking a risk has no control, but does not include
2 any of the following:

3
4 (D) Bingo games ~~conducted, or pull tabs~~
5 ~~sold, by charitable or nonprofit organizations where the~~
6 ~~tickets for the bingo are sold only in this state and the~~
7 ~~pull tabs are sold only on the premises owned or occupied~~
8 ~~by the charitable or nonprofit organization provided that:~~
9 and pull tab game events authorized by W.S. 16-13-102.

11 **Section 3.** W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iii)(D)(I) through (V) is
12 repealed.

14 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
