A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to attorneys at law; providing for the
2 appointment and conditions of office of the board of law
3 examiners pursuant to Wyoming supreme court rules; and
4 providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-5-101 is amended to read:

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10 **33-5-101. State board of law examiners; appointment.**

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12 The state board of law examiners shall ~~consist of five (5)~~
13 ~~members of the bar of at least five (5) years standing, who~~
14 ~~shall~~ be appointed by the supreme court, and shall hold
15 office ~~for the term of three (3) years; provided, that not~~

1 ~~more than one (1) member shall be appointed from the same~~
2 ~~judicial district. In case a vacancy shall occur by death,~~
3 ~~resignation or otherwise, the same shall be filled by~~
4 ~~appointment by the court for the remainder of the term of~~
5 ~~the member whose place has become vacant. Removal of a~~
6 ~~member from the district in which he resided when appointed~~
7 ~~shall be construed as creating a vacancy~~ pursuant to rules
8 promulgated by the supreme court.

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10 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
