A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state agency planning; modifying
2 legislative review requirements; repealing provisions
3 related to major program reports by the legislative service
4 office; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-1-115(a)(ii)(intro) and (A) is
9 amended to read:

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11 **28-1-115. Submission of state agency plans to**
12 **legislature; contents; purposes.**

14 (a) To assist the legislature in its deliberations,
15 every state agency shall:

16

1 (ii) As required by the governor or by the
2 legislature ~~in a budget bill or other enactment~~ by law,
3 develop a multi-year plan to accomplish and further the
4 goals and objectives defined in W.S. 28-1-116(a). The plan
5 development shall include an opportunity for public review
6 and comment. The plan shall be submitted to the governor
7 for his approval. The plan shall:

8
9 (A) Include performance measures that
10 provide methods and criteria to measure the agency's
11 performance in conducting its activities and in achieving
12 its goals and objectives. The methods and criteria shall
13 comply with standards developed by the governmental
14 accounting standards board. Performance measures shall be
15 developed by the agency ~~and reviewed by the legislative~~
16 ~~management audit committee~~ and audited by the department of
17 audit. Performance measures shall also be reviewed by the
18 legislative management audit committee:

19
20 (I) If required by management council
21 or by the management audit committee on its own motion;
22

1 (II) If required by management council
2 upon request of the governor; or

3

4 (III) If the legislature requires the
5 review by law.

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7 **Section 2.** W.S. 28-1-115(e) is repealed.

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9 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
11 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
12 Constitution.
