Agency reporting transparency.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; requiring  
2 public reports on state spending and revenues as specified;  
3 requiring the posting of state entity requests and  
4 contracts for supplies and services as specified; requiring  
5 the posting of certain information on employees of the  
6 state as specified; prohibiting redaction of reports posted  
7 on the Wyoming public finance and expenditure of funds  
8 website as specified; and providing for effective dates.

10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1016 by creating a new subsection  
13 (m), 9-2-1022(a)(iv) and 9-2-1036(c) by creating a new  
14 paragraph (iv), (d)(ii)(intro), and by creating new  
15 subsections (h) and (j) are amended to read:

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2           **9-2-1016. General services division.**

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4           (m) The department through the general services  
5 division shall make available for public inspection on the  
6 Wyoming public finance and expenditure of funds website  
7 created by W.S. 9-2-1036(a) a copy of any request for bids  
8 or proposals by an agency for supplies or services or any  
9 contract or other agreement entered into by an agency for  
10 supplies or services. For the purpose of this subsection  
11 the term "agency" does not include the University of  
12 Wyoming, community college districts or school districts.

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14           **9-2-1022. Duties of department performed through**  
15 **human resources division.**

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17           (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the  
18 department through the human resources division shall:

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20           (iv) Collect, in a format prescribed by the  
21 department, and maintain an—information roster—on each  
22 employee of the state specifying employee name, employing  
23 agency, position classification, rate of compensation, job

1 title, position description and service tenure. The  
2 information shall be available and updated annually for  
3 public inspection ~~only as provided by the Public Records~~  
4 ~~Act~~ on the Wyoming public finance and expenditure of funds  
5 website created by W.S. 9-2-1036(a). For purposes of this  
6 paragraph, "employee of the state" means an employee of the  
7 executive or judicial branch of government, the University  
8 of Wyoming or any community college in the state;  
9

10 **9-2-1036. Wyoming public finance and expenditure of**  
11 **funds website.**

13 (c) The department shall:

14  
15 (iv) Post or provide a link on the website to  
16 any public financial information specifically required by  
17 law to be made available for inclusion on the website.  
18

19 (d) The department may:

20  
21 (ii) Determine what public financial information  
22 shall be provided by participating state entities, subject

1 to subsection (h) of this section and provided that the  
2 public financial information:

3  
4 (h) Each participating state entity shall provide to  
5 the department for inclusion on the website quarterly  
6 reports accounting for all revenues, regardless of source,  
7 received by the participating state entity that qualify as  
8 public financial information.

9  
10 (j) Public financial information posted on the  
11 website shall not be redacted except to the extent  
12 necessary to exclude any information which is confidential  
13 or privileged by law.

14  
15 **Section 2.** The department of administration and  
16 information shall collect and post the information required  
17 by W.S. 9-2-1022(a)(iv), as amended by this act, to the  
18 Wyoming public finance and expenditure of funds website  
19 created by W.S. 9-2-1036(a) not later than July 1, 2018.  
20 The information shall be updated on the website annually as  
21 required by W.S. 9-2-1022(a)(iv), as amended by this act.

23 **Section 3.**

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2           (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this  
3 section, this act is effective July 1, 2018.

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5           (b) Section 2 of this act is effective immediately  
6 upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become  
7 law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
8 Constitution.

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10           **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
