A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to commercial vehicles; specifying that
2 federal rules requiring electronic logging devices are not
3 required under Wyoming law; preventing Wyoming officers
4 from enforcing specified federal requirements; requiring
5 rulemaking; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-18-303 by creating a new
10 subsection (f) is amended to read:

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12 **31-18-303. Authority of department to adopt rules and**
13 **regulations governing drivers, equipment and hazardous**
14 **materials; exceptions; maximum operating hours.**

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(f) The department shall adopt rules prescribing the permissible operating time and other requirements of motor carrier drivers and equipment standards that are comparable to rules established before the December 16, 2015 rules as published in the Federal Register volume 80:241 page 78292, notwithstanding requirements to comport with United States department of transportation rules and regulations in subsections (a) and (c) of this section. In Wyoming no officer as defined in W.S. 31-5-102(a)(xxxi) or 31-1-203(a) shall enforce any rule or regulation for permissible operating time and equipment standards except as provided in this subsection and department rules promulgated according to this subsection.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
