A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to food and drugs; expanding the drug
2 donation and redispensing program as specified; creating a
3 definition; authorizing a position; providing an
4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-1602(a)(i) and by creating a new
9 paragraph (iii) and 35-7-1603(b) by creating a new
10 paragraph (viii) are amended to read:

12 **35-7-1602. Definitions.**

13

14 (a) For purposes of this act:

15

1 (i) "Prescription drug" means a pharmaceutical
2 drug which is required by any applicable federal or state
3 law to be dispensed only pursuant to a health care
4 provider's prescription;~~and~~

6 (iii) "Department" means the department of
7 health.

8
9 **35-7-1603. Drug donation, redispensing and disposal**
10 **program established; minimum requirements.**

11
12 (b) The drug donation and redispensing program shall
13 have the following features:

14
15 (viii) The department shall provide access to
16 computer systems and technical assistance to aid
17 individuals in applying for government and private
18 prescription drug programs and discounts.

19
20 **Section 2.** The department of health is authorized one
21 (1) additional part-time position for the biennium
22 beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2020 to
23 implement the purposes of this act. The department of

1 health shall include this position authorization and any
2 necessary funding for the position in its 2021-2022
3 standard budget request.

4

5 **Section 3.** For the period beginning with the
6 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2020, there
7 is appropriated sixty-five thousand one hundred twenty
8 dollars (\$65,120.00) from the general fund to the
9 department of health. This appropriation shall only be
10 expended to implement the purposes of this act.
11 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
12 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
13 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
14 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
15 by law on June 30, 2020.

16

17 **Section 4.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
