Catch Title: State parks designations-updates.

Subject: State parks, historic sites, archaeological sites, and recreation areas.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law designates certain lands as state historic sites. This act updates designations to some of those historic sites. Specifically, the following designations are added or updated in this act:
 - The lands in Platte County designated as the Oregon Trail State Historic Site will now include the Trail Ruts and Register Cliff Units.
 - Lands in Converse County are designated as the Camp Douglas State Historic Site.
 - Lands in Campbell County are designated as the LX Bar Ranch State Historic Site.
- In addition, this act removes the state historic site designation for lands in Lander County that were previously designated as the Lander Cemetery State Historic Site.

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
