Catch Title: Wildlife conservation license plates.

Subject: Wildlife conservation license plates contributing to wildlife

conservation efforts related to the transportation system.

Summary/Major Elements:

• This act allows for the creation and sale of wildlife conservation license plates for any motor vehicle that is not a commercial or multipurpose vehicle.

- This act establishes an application fee of \$150 for the new plates, with a separate annual fee of \$50. The fees collected must be deposited into a separate account and used only for wildlife conservation efforts related to the transportation system, including game fences and wildlife corridors and crossings.
- The Department of Transportation must design the wildlife conservation license plates and arrange for production of the plates.

Comments:

- This act requires the Department of Transportation to report to the Legislature no later than January 15, 2025 if less than 1,000 sets of wildlife plates are issued before December 21, 2023.
- This act is effective January 1, 2019, except the section requiring the Department of Transportation to design the plates is effective immediately.
