Catch Title: **Impersonation through electronic means-spoofing.**

Subject: Amending the crime of unlawful impersonation/spoofing.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act amends the crime of unlawful impersonation through electronic means. Under current law, a person is guilty of unlawful impersonation through electronic means if he knowingly and without consent intentionally impersonates another person and causes or attempts to cause harm. This act amends the crime to prohibit a person from knowingly and without consent intentionally impersonating another person and:
 - Causes or attempts to cause harm;
 - Harasses or attempts to harass another person while using false self-identifying information; or
 - Uses or attempts to use false self-identifying information as an unauthorized deceptive means to facilitate contact with another person.

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
