Catch Title: Approval of bridge designs, plans and specifications.

Subject: Removing the requirement for Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) approval of all bridges and specifying the inspection process when WYDOT approval is not required.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill eliminates the requirement for WYDOT preparation or approval of bridge plans and specifications. This bill specifies that requirements for county bridge designs, plans, specifications, construction, examination and approval apply to cities and towns.
- This bill requires notice to WYDOT's chief engineer of a constructed bridge, including the design, plans, specifications and load rating for the bridge so that WYDOT may comply with national bridge inspection standards.
- WYDOT will continue to provide standard plans, specifications, data and consultation for bridges to cities, towns and counties as requested or needed.

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
