Catch Title: **Commercial driver's license-compact agreement.**

Subject: Requesting Congress to pass legislation authorizing Western states to enter a compact for commercial drivers between 18 and 21 years of age.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Federal law currently provides that drivers with commercial driver licenses must be 21 years of age to operate a commercial motor vehicle across state lines.
- This resolution requests Congress to enact legislation authorizing Western states to enter into a voluntary compact that would allow commercial drivers between 18 and 21 years of age to operate a commercial motor vehicle in a consenting, contiguous state.
