**Catch Title:** 150th Anniversary of the 1868 Treaty of Fort Bridger.

**Subject:** Commemoration of the signing of the 1868 Treaty of Fort Bridger.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This joint resolution commemorates the signing of the Treaty of Fort Bridger on July 3, 1868 at Fort Bridger, in the Utah Territory, which is now present-day Wyoming.
- The joint resolution acknowledges celebrations that are planned to celebrate the signing of the Treaty and supports nationwide public education about the heritage, history and contributions of Native American tribes. The joint resolution urges the federal government to uphold its federal trust responsibilities.
- The resolution expresses the Wyoming Legislature's support for permanently displaying in Wyoming the original 1868 Treaty of Fort Bridger, which is presently on file with the National Archives.

**Comments:**

- Requires the Secretary of State to send copies of the resolution to national and tribal leaders.
