Catch Title: **Purple Heart Day and state.**

Subject: Establishing a Purple Heart Day in Wyoming and designating Wyoming as a Purple Heart State.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act designates Wyoming as a Purple Heart State in recognition of military service members—including Wyoming citizens—who were wounded or killed in combat.
- This act also establishes August 7 of each year as Purple Heart Day in Wyoming and requires the Veterans' Commission to work with military and local organizations to observe the day with appropriate activities and programs.

NOTE: Final action on this bill was not taken at the time this summary was prepared.
