Catch Title: Elections-notices and resolutions.

Subject: Election notices and resolutions.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This act amends time periods for the following election notices:
 - Bond question notices provided to the county clerk from a political subdivision;
 - Bond election notices published by county clerks;
 - Special district organizational election notices published by county clerks.
- The act amends the time period for special districts candidate application filings.
- Currently, county clerks are required to publish proclamations between 45 and 35 days before each general election. This act modifies that time period to between 90 and 70 days before each general election and also modifies the content required in such proclamations.
- Currently, special hospital districts are formed as provided in the Special District Elections Act of 1994. The act authorizes as an alternative to those procedures, the formation of special hospital districts by county commissioner resolution and election.
