Catch Title: **Board of law examiners appointment-supreme court rules.**

Subject: Providing for the appointment and conditions of office for the board of law examiners pursuant to Wyoming supreme court rules.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Existing statute requires the Supreme Court to appoint the members of the board of law examiners. This board is responsible for administering and grading the bar admission test. Existing statute specifies the number of board members, the length of the members' terms and imposes a prohibition on more than one member from the same judicial district. This act deletes these provisions and simply requires that the members of the board be appointed and hold office pursuant to rules promulgated by the Supreme Court.

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
