Catch Title: 150th Anniversary of the 1868 Treaty of Fort Laramie.

Subject: Commemoration of the signing of the 1868 Treaty of Fort Laramie.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Throughout 1868 at Fort Laramie, Wyoming and other military posts in the region, the indigenous Nations of the northern Great Plains region entered into peace treaties with the United States of America. These treaties are collectively regarded as the 1868 Treaty of Fort Laramie.
- This joint resolution commemorates the signing of those treaties and acknowledges planned celebrations.
- This joint resolution supports nationwide public education about the heritage, history, and contributions of Native American tribes and urges the federal government to uphold its federal trust responsibilities.
- This joint resolution also expresses the Wyoming Legislature's support for permanently displaying in Wyoming the original treaties that comprise the 1868 Treaty of Fort Laramie, which are presently on file with the National Archives.

Comments:

- Requires the Secretary of State to send copies of the resolution to national and tribal leaders.
