9 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-23-108 is created to read:

11 1-23-108. Construction contracts; indemnity

12 provisions; applicable law.

1	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
2	provision in a construction contract is void and
3	unenforceable if the provision:
4	
5	(i) Indemnifies an indemnitee from liability for
6	damages arising from any negligence or the intentional acts
7	or omissions of the indemnitee;
8	
9	(ii) Requires a party to provide liability
10	coverage to another party for the other party's negligence or
11	the intentional acts or omissions of the other party.
12	
13	(b) A construction contract may contain a provision
14	that:
15	
16	(i) Indemnifies an indemnitee, or the agent,
17	employee or contractor of the indemnitee, from any negligence
18	arising from the negligence or the intentional acts or
19	omissions of the indemnitor;
20	
21	(ii) Requires a person to purchase a project
22	insurance policy, including protective insurance, project
23	management liability insurance or builder's risk insurance.

2 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to

3 restrict indemnification of a surety on a construction

4 contract bond or to modify the obligation of an insurer to

5 its insured persons.

7 (d) All construction contracts relating to work that

8 takes place in Wyoming shall be governed by the laws of this

9 state.

11 (e) As used in this section:

12

13 (i) "Construction contract" means an agreement for

14 architectural services, alterations, construction,

15 demolition, design services, development, engineering

16 services, surveying services, excavation, maintenance, repair

17 or other services related to an improvement to real property,

18 including any agreement to supply labor, materials, fixtures,

19 furniture or equipment for an improvement to real property;

20

21 (ii) "Indemnify" means an agreement in which risk

22 is assigned to one (1) or more parties and includes agreements

23 to defend, hold harmless or insure from liability.

Section 2. This act applies to contracts entered into
or renewed on or after July 1, 2019.

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2019.
