When declaration of party affiliation 14 required. 15 16 An elector requesting a major party ballot must declare his 17 party affiliation, or sign an application for change of affiliation, in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214, before he may 18 19 receive a party ballot. An elector may vote only the 20 nonpartisan ballot and if so, is not required to declare his party affiliation. Requesting a partisan primary election 21 ballot constitutes a declaration of party affiliation. A 22
