for

1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; amending eligibility

- 2 criteria for the tax refund to the elderly and disabled

- 6 effective dates.

1 Refunds. The following shall apply: (C) 2 3 (i) As used in this subsection: 4 5 (A) "Department" means the department 6 health revenue; 7 8 (ii) Wyoming residents meeting asset eligibility 9 requirements under paragraph (vii) of this subsection who are 10 sixty-five (65) years of age and older or who are eighteen 11 (18) years of age and older and are totally disabled during 12 the one (1) year period immediately preceding the date of application for a refund under this subsection and are not 13 residents of any state funded institution, are qualified for 14 an exemption and refund of state taxes as provided in this 15 16 subsection. The application shall indicate whether the 17 applicant has applied for or received any refund under this section, a property tax exemption under W.S. 39-13-105, a 18 19 property tax refund under W.S. 39-13-109(c)(v) or a property 20 tax credit under W.S. 39-13-109(d) for the same calendar year. 21 Subject to legislative appropriation for the program, a qualified single person whose actual income is less than 22

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- 10 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund two
- 11 million five hundred sixteen thousand three hundred
- 12 fifty-seven dollars (\$2,516,357.00) to the department of
- 13 revenue for the purpose of providing the refunds offered under
- 14 W.S. 39-11-109(c)(ii) and for the purposes of funding the
- 15 position authorized in subsection (b) of this section.
- 16 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
- 17 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
- 18 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining
- 19 from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on
- 20 June 30, 2020.

- 22 (b) The department of revenue is authorized one (1)
- 23 additional full-time permanent position to implement the

- 1 purposes of this act. From funds appropriated in subsection
- 2 (a) of this section, up to one hundred ninety-four thousand
- 3 dollars (\$194,000.00) shall only be expended to fund the
- 4 position authorized in this subsection for the period
- 5 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June
- 6 30, 2020.

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- 8 **Section 3.** On or before July 1, 2019, the department of
- 9 revenue shall adopt rules necessary to implement this act.
- 10 Any rules adopted by the department of revenue in accordance
- 11 with this section shall take effect on July 1, 2019. Any
- 12 rules adopted by the department of health in accordance with
- 13 W.S. 39-11-109(c)(vi) shall continue in effect through June
- 14 30, 2019.

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16 Section 4.

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- 18 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
- 19 section, this act is effective immediately upon completion of
- 20 all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by
- 21 Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.

1 (b) Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective July 1,
