A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to mixed martial arts regulation; modifying
- 2 a provision relating to bonds for mixed martials arts matches;
- 3 modifying duties of board representatives as specified; and
- 4 providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-48-106, 33-48-107(a)(i), 33-48-109
- 9 and 33-48-110 are amended to read:

11 33-48-106. License application; fee and bond.

12

- 13 Application for a license to conduct mixed martial arts
- 14 matches shall be in writing, shall be addressed to the board
- 15 and shall be verified by the individual promoter or by an

1 officer of the club, organization or corporation on whose 2 behalf the application is made. The application shall be 3 accompanied by a fee as established by the board in accordance 4 with W.S. 33-1-201. The application shall show that the club, 5 organization or corporation has been in existence not less than thirty (30) days. Before any license is issued under 6 7 chapter to any person, club, organization this 8 corporation, the applicant shall file with the state 9 treasurer a bond in an amount established by the board, not 10 to exceed the greater of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or the total estimated expenses associated with the match, with 11 12 good and sufficient surety, conditioned for the faithful 13 performance of the conditions of this chapter. The applicant shall provide an estimate of the expenses for the match based 14 15 on matches held at venues with similar audience capacity and 16 other relevant factors. The board shall verify that the application contains a good faith estimate of anticipated 17 18 expenses for the match.

9 or corporation. The report shall show the number of tickets
10 sold for the match, the amount of gross proceeds from the
11 match and other matters as the board may prescribe; and

13 **33-48-109.** Amateur matches.

15 Whenever an amateur mixed martial arts match is held by any 16 person, club, organization or corporation, and the match is 17 not for pecuniary profit, the license fee and bond provisions of W.S. 33-48-106, the reporting and fee provisions of W.S. 18 19 33-48-107, the presence of a board member and the deputy or 20 inspector board representative provisions of W.S. 33-48-110 21 shall not apply. The match shall, however, be subject to all 22 other provisions of this chapter and the rules and regulations of the board. 23

2 33-48-110. Board representatives.

4 The board shall, after consultation with the county commissioners of the several counties, appoint official 5 6 representatives designated as inspectors and deputy inspectors board representatives for each county the state. 7 Each inspector and deputy board representative shall receive 8 9 from the board a card authorizing him to act as an inspector 10 a representative wherever the board may designate him to act. Any A board member may, and at least one (1) inspector or 11 12 deputy board representative shall, be present at all matches 13 conducted for pecuniary profit and see that the rules and 14 regulations of the board are strictly observed. An inspector 15 or deputy shall A board representative may also be present at 16 the counting of the gross receipts and, if present, shall 17 immediately mail without undue delay provide to the board the written report received by the inspector or deputy board 18 19 representative from the individual promoter or officer of the 20 club, organization or corporation showing the number of 21 tickets sold, the gross amount of proceeds and other matters as the board may prescribe. 22 The board may establish 23 compensation for, and pay, any inspectors or deputies board 1 <u>representatives</u> appointed under this section from fees

2 deposited in the mixed martial arts board account in

3 accordance with W.S. 33-1-202 and this chapter.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

6 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as

7 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
