## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the collection agency board; amending the
- 2 number of members of the collection agency board as specified;
- 3 specifying composition of board members; making conforming
- 4 amendments; specifying applicability; requiring appointments
- 5 as specified; and providing for effective dates.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-11-103(a) and (b) and 33-11-105(a)
- 10 are amended to read:

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12 33-11-103. Collection agency board created;

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13 membership; appointment; term; qualifications; chairman.

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| 1  | (a) The collection agency board is created. The board         |
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| 2  | shall consist of three (3) five (5) members appointed by the  |
| 3  | governor. One (1) member shall be an attorney-at-law who is   |
| 4  | actively engaged in collection work. One (1) Two (2) members  |
| 5  | shall be an officer, partner, owner or resident manager       |
| 6  | officers, partners, owners or resident managers of a licensed |
| 7  | collection agencies but not from the same or affiliated       |
| 8  | collection agency, and who is are not an attorney at law      |
| 9  | attorneys-at-law. One (1) member shall be a member of the     |
| 10 | public at large who is neither an attorney-at-law nor         |
| 11 | affiliated with a collection agency, but who is or has been   |
| 12 | a user of credit or collection services. Commencing in 1993,  |
| 13 | One (1) member shall be a grantor of credit operating in the  |
| 14 | state that engages or has engaged the services of a Wyoming   |
| 15 | licensed collection agency. Members of the board shall be     |
| 16 | appointed for a term of four (4) years. Members of the board  |
| 17 | and shall serve until their successors are duly appointed and |
| 18 | qualified.  |
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(b) No person shall be appointed as a member of the board who has not been a bona fide resident of the state of Wyoming for at least five (5) years immediately prior to his appointment. The attorney and the officer, partner, owner or 23

- 1 resident manager officers, partners, owners or resident
- 2 <u>managers</u> of <u>a the</u> collection <u>agency agencies</u> shall have been
- 3 engaged in the collection business within the state of Wyoming
- 4 for a period of five (5) years immediately prior to
- 5 appointment. The member of the public at large shall have at
- 6 least five (5) years experience as a user of credit or
- 7 collection services.

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- 9 33-11-105. Powers and duties of collection agency
- 10 board.

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- 12 (a) The board shall assist and advise the chairman, who
- 13 shall have charge of the administration of this act. All
- 14 applications for licenses under this act shall be referred by
- 15 the chairman to the board for consideration. The board shall
- 16 investigate the qualifications of the applicant. If the board
- 17 finds the applicant fails to meet the required
- 18 qualifications, the board shall reject the application;
- 19 otherwise the application shall be approved and a license
- 20 issued granted on payment of license fees and filing of a

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21 bond as required by this act.

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| 1  | Section 2. Appointed members currently serving on the         |
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| 2  | collection agency board may continue to serve on the board,   |
| 3  | as modified by this act, until the expiration of their terms  |
| 4  | under W.S. 33-11-103(a).                                      |
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| 6  | Section 3. The governor shall appoint the two (2)             |
| 7  | additional members to the collection agency board as provided |
| 8  | in W.S. 33-11-103(a) as amended by section 1 of this act not  |
| 9  | later than July 1, 2019.                                      |
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| 11 | Section 4.  |
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| 13 | (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section,     |
| 14 | this act is effective July 1, 2019.                           |
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| 16 | (b) Sections 3 and 4 are effective immediately upon           |
| 17 | completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  |
| 18 | provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. |
