Alcoholic beverages-24 hour permit.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; authorizing alcoholic  
2 liquor manufacturers to obtain off-premises permits; making  
3 a conforming amendment; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-2-203(g), 12-4-103(a)(vi) and  
8 12-5-401 are amended to read:

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10 **12-2-203. Manufacturing and rectifying; importing and**  
11 **industry representatives; licensing; fees.**

13 (g) The local licensing authority may issue to the  
14 holder of a manufacturer's license granted under subsection

1 (a) of this section who is a federally licensed distiller or  
2 rectifier~~;~~

4 (i) A satellite manufacturer's permit which allows  
5 the permittee to sell product manufactured at the site  
6 identified on the manufacturer's license at not more than one  
7 (1) satellite location within Wyoming separate from its  
8 manufacturing site under the original permit. All products  
9 sold at a manufacturer's satellite location shall be obtained  
10 through the division. The satellite manufacturer's permit may  
11 be issued on application to the appropriate licensing  
12 authority. The local licensing authority may require a public  
13 hearing and the payment of an additional permit fee not to  
14 exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). The satellite  
15 manufacturer's permit shall be subject to the terms and  
16 conditions of W.S. 12-4-106, the schedule of operating hours  
17 set pursuant to W.S. 12-5-101 and the licensed building  
18 provisions pursuant to W.S. 12-5-201~~;~~

20 (ii) A manufacturer's off-premises permit  
21 authorizing the permittee to sell product manufactured at the  
22 site identified on the manufacturer's license only for sales  
23 at meetings, conventions, private parties, dinners and other

1 similar gatherings to promote their product. No permittee  
2 holding a manufacturer's off-premises permit shall sell or  
3 permit consumption of any of their manufactured product off  
4 the premises described in the permit. An off-premises permit  
5 shall be issued for one (1) twenty-four (24) hour period,  
6 subject to the schedule of operating hours set pursuant to  
7 W.S. 12-5-101. No holder of a manufacturer's license shall  
8 receive more than twelve (12) off-premises permits in any one  
9 (1) calendar year. An off-premises permit may be issued on  
10 application to the appropriate licensing authority. The local  
11 licensing authority may require payment of an additional  
12 permit fee of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more  
13 than fifty dollars (\$50.00) per twenty-four (24) hour period.

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15       **12-4-103. Restrictions upon license or permit**  
16 **applicants and holders; license limitation per person.**

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18       (a) A license or permit authorized by this title shall  
19 not be held by, issued or transferred to:

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21               (vi) A manufacturer of alcoholic beverages or  
22 wholesaler of malt beverages, except as authorized under W.S.

23 12-2-203(g);

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2           **12-5-401. Interests in licenses or permits to sell.**

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4 No industry representative shall hold any interest, stock or  
5 ownership directly or indirectly, in any license to sell  
6 products of the industry at retail under privileges of a  
7 license or permit to sell any beverage or liquor in Wyoming  
8 or in any premises so licensed. This section shall not apply  
9 to any person holding a microbrewery or winery permit pursuant  
10 to W.S. 12-4-412. This section shall also not apply to a  
11 person holding a manufacturer's license under W.S.  
12 12-2-203(a) to the extent he may be permitted one (1)  
13 satellite manufacturer's permit pursuant to W.S. ~~12-2-203(g)~~  
14 12-2-203(g)(i) or an off-premises permit pursuant to W.S.  
15 12-2-203(g)(ii).

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17           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
