1 AN ACT relating to pension accounts; amending the volunteer

2 firefighter and EMT pension account to provide membership for

- 3 volunteer search and rescue personnel; providing for
- 4 contributions to the account; increasing insurance premiums
- 5 to the account as specified; amending membership of the
- 6 pension account board; making conforming amendments; and
- 7 providing for an effective date.

9 (c) The retirement system including the Wyoming state 10 highway patrol, game and fish warden and criminal investigator retirement program, any paid firemen's pension 11 12 plan established under the firemen's pension account created 13 by W.S. 15-5-202 and any plan through the volunteer firefighter, and EMT and search and rescue pension account 14 35-9-617, shall pay retirement 15 established under W.S. 16 benefits in accordance with any qualified domestic relations 17 order for the payment of a specified percentage of a member's 18 benefits or account to an alternate payee, for a specified 19 number of payments or period of time and from a specified 20 retirement plan. Upon request of the alternate payee, a lump 21 sum refund of the alternate payee's percentage of the member's account shall be paid pursuant to the qualified domestic 22 23 relations order. Acceptance by the alternate payee of the

- 2 or benefit provided by the retirement system. Notwithstanding

1 firefighting or EMT services shall pay to the pension account 2 the amount required under W.S. 35-9-621(e) for those members. 3 The county for whom a volunteer search and rescue person 4 performs search and rescue services shall pay to the pension account the amount required under W.S. 35-9-621(e) for those 5 6 members. Payments shall be collected upon terms conditions established by the board under W.S. 35-9-621(e) 7 8 and shall be forwarded by each collecting officer to the state 9 retirement director for deposit in the account. Any entity 10 listed in this subsection may elect to provide for a member's contribution or any portion thereof provided that any payment 11 12 of a contribution is made on behalf of a member. Whether an 13 entity makes a contribution for a member shall be at the 14 discretion of the entity as an incentive to improve their local volunteer fire department, or emergency medical 15

22 (e) A volunteer firefighter or volunteer EMT is a 23 participating member under this article for each month a

1 contribution of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) is made by or on behalf of the member. A volunteer search and rescue person is 2 3 a participating member under this article for each month a 4 contribution of thirty dollars (\$30.00) is made by or on 5 behalf of the member. For purposes of eligibility for benefits under subsections (b) and (c) of this section, a 6 volunteer firefighter, or search and rescue person is 7 8 a participating member beginning the first month following 9 the month in which the required monthly payment and any 10 required application for participation is actually received Wyoming retirement system. To continue 11 bу the as 12 participating member, subsequent monthly payments shall be 13 received by the Wyoming retirement system not later than three (3) months following the close of the calendar month for which 14 15 the payments are applicable. With the consent of and upon any 16 terms and conditions established by the board, payments may 17 be accepted at an earlier or later date. The board shall maintain full and complete records of the contributions made 18 19 on behalf of each participating member and on request, shall 20 furnish any participating member a statement of the contribution amounts and the dates for which contributions 21 were received. If contributions have varied in amount, the 22 23 board may make appropriate adjustments in the benefits

1 awarded. In making any adjustment, the board shall be guided

2 by actuarial practice to afford substantial equity to members

3 of the pension account. No penalty shall be imposed upon any

4 participating member transferring employment in Wyoming if

5 required payments are made on a timely basis.

6

(j) Any participating member with at least five (5) 7 years of participation in the pension account who retires 8 9 from active service as a volunteer firefighter, or EMT or 10 search and rescue person before reaching retirement age and 11 does not withdraw from the pension account as provided in 12 subsection (f) of this section shall be entitled to a monthly 13 benefit payment as provided in subsection (a) of this section upon reaching the retirement age specified in subsection (d) 14 15 of this section. A member with ten (10) or more years of 16 active participation in the pension account may choose to 17 himself from active service remove as a volunteer firefighter, or search and rescue person and continue 18 19 to contribute to the pension account for an amount of time 20 not to exceed the total number of years the member was an 21 active participant in the pension account, as provided in subsection (e) of this section and rules promulgated by the 22 23 board.

4	Death benefits received under this article shall be in
5	addition to, and are payable after the application of,
6	worker's compensation benefits which are payable to volunteer
7	firefighters, or volunteer EMTs or volunteer search and
8	rescue persons under the Wyoming Worker's Compensation Act.

10	35-9-623. Board; established; nomination; appointment;
11	terms and qualification of members; first members.

13	(a) The volunteer firefighter, and EMT and search and
14	rescue pension board is created. The board shall control the
15	account.
16	
17	(b) The board shall consist of seven (7) eight (8)
18	members who shall be appointed by the governor to staggered
19	terms of three (3) years. The governor may remove any board
20	member as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. Of these board members:
21	
22	(i) Six (6) members shall be volunteer
23	firefighters who have a minimum of five (5) years service as

1	a volunteer firefighter in the state. Appointments under this
2	paragraph shall be made from nominees recommended to the
3	governor by the Wyoming state firemen's association; and
4	
5	(ii) One (1) member shall be a volunteer EMT who
6	has a minimum of five (5) years service as a volunteer EMT in
7	the state. Appointments under this paragraph shall be made
8	by the governor: and
9	
10	(iii) One (1) member shall be a volunteer search
11	and rescue person who has a minimum of five (5) years service
12	as a volunteer search and rescue person in the state.
13	Appointments under this paragraph shall be made by the
14	governor.

16	35-9-628. Deposit of tax on fire insurance premiums
17	into account.
18	
19	(a) As provided in this subsection, the state treasurer
20	shall deposit into the account an amount not to exceed seventy
21	<pre>percent (70%) eighty percent (80%)</pre> of the gross tax levied

upon fire insurance premiums paid to insurance companies for

fire insurance in the state of Wyoming for the preceding

calendar quarter, as computed under W.S. 26-4-102(b)(ii) and provided by W.S. 26-4-103(k). The sum specified shall be calculated by the Wyoming retirement system:
