#### A BILL

### for

1 AN ACT relating to state funded capital construction; providing definitions; providing appropriations and increasing prior 2 appropriations for purposes related to state funded capital 3 construction; modifying prior appropriations; making certain 4 appropriations subject to specified terms and conditions; 5 providing matching funds for specified projects; authorizing б 7 legislative meeting facilities; providing an appropriation for 8 an advisory task force related to state facilities; requiring 9 reports; and providing for an effective date.

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As a condition of this general fund appropriation, the community college
 to which the funds are appropriated shall expend the entire appropriation of
 other funds prior to the release of any general funds appropriated for
 purposes of the authorized capital construction project.

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6 2. Casper College shall complete requirements specified in footnotes 1 and
7 3 of this section for the Casper College-Agriculture and Equine Center
8 appropriation before release of the general fund appropriation for the Casper
9 College-Visual Arts Building.

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3. For the Casper College-Agriculture and Equine Center, any funds expended pursuant to 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 26, Section 3, Section 006, footnote 5, up to seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000.00), shall be considered expenditures of other funds for purposes of footnote 1 of this section if the Casper College-Agriculture and Equine Center is constructed on the property acquired from that expenditure.

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18 4. Of this general fund appropriation, five hundred thousand dollars 19 (\$500,000.00) shall only be expended upon a determination by the governor, 20 in consultation with Western Wyoming Community College and the state 21 construction department, that insufficient appropriations are available to 22 address emergency repair needs related to building system failures at the 23 college.

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25 5. Of this other funds appropriation, three million one hundred eighty-four 26 thousand one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$3,184,125.00)T5, or as much

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thereof as is available, is effective immediately and shall be expended on water mitigation projects, maintenance and repairs at the Wyoming state penitentiary recommended pursuant to the penal facility peer review study conducted under 2017 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 120, Section 332 and on file with the legislative service office.

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7 6. Of this other funds appropriation, five million dollars 8 (\$5,000,000.00)T5, or as much thereof as is available, shall be expended for 9 operations, major maintenance, capital construction, repairs or inmate 10 relocation in the event hazardous conditions resulting from subsurface 11 movement or other building failure at any correctional facility of the 12 department of corrections warrants an immediate response. Expenditures of 13 the appropriation subject to this footnote shall be made only upon the 14 approval of the governor after consultation with the joint appropriations 15 committee. The department of corrections shall report quarterly to the joint 16 appropriations committee on expenditures made from this appropriation 17 subject to this footnote. Any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from 18 the appropriation subject to this footnote shall revert as provided by law 19 on June 30, 2020.

21 7. Funds from this appropriation shall be deposited in the state facilities 22 construction account. This appropriation shall be effective immediately.

24 8. Funds from this appropriation shall be deposited to the Casper state 25 facilities account created in W.S. 9-4-223.

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1	9. Of this general fund appropriation, sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000.00)
2	shall only be expended for costs of abatement associated with the remodel of
3	the Maghee building in Fremont County.
4	
5	10. Funds from this appropriation shall be deposited into the state
6	facilities construction account. In addition to amounts appropriated in
7	2017 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 78 and 2018 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter
8	136 for the Wyoming state hospital and Wyoming life resource center, up to
9	three million five hundred thousand dollars (\$3,500,000.00) from the state
10	facilities construction account is appropriated for abatement activities at
11	the Wyoming life resource center.

15	Section 3. There is appropriated forty thousand dollars
16	(\$40,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative service
17	office. This appropriation shall only be expended for the
18	purpose of funding salary, mileage and per diem of legislative
19	members of the joint legislative and executive task force on
20	department of health facilities as constituted in 2017 Wyoming
21	Session Laws, Chapter 78. Notwithstanding any other provision
22	of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended

for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30 of the year following the year in which

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1	facilities. The meeting rooms and facilities shall
2	consist of two (2) meeting rooms with all necessary
3	components to accommodate meetings of joint interim
4	committees of the legislature and such additional
5	areas and facilities as necessary to support the
6	intended functions of the meeting rooms. The meeting
7	rooms and related facilities shall be located in an
8	area of the building that provides for ease of public
9	access and does not unduly disrupt the intended uses
10	of the other occupants of the building. The meeting
11	rooms and facilities shall be under the jurisdiction
12	and control of the legislative service office.
13	Legislative use of the meeting rooms and facilities
14	shall be given first priority, but the rooms and
15	facilities shall be open for use by the executive
16	branch occupants of the building and compatible use
17	by the public. Subject to legislative prioritization,
18	these spaces shall be managed to maximize use for all
19	authorized users and purposes as provided in this
20	subsection. The meeting rooms and facilities shall be
21	designed, constructed, finished, furnished and
22	equipped to provide:

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1	(i) Necessary committee dais space for at
2	least fourteen (14) committee members and necessary
3	<pre>staff;</pre>

5	(ii) Appropriate accommodations for
6	witnesses and seating for between thirty-five (35)
7	and one hundred (100) members of the public;

9	(iii) Appropriate information technology
10	and audio-visual infrastructure and equipment
11	necessary to provide speech reinforcement, video
12	monitor presentation capability, audio conferencing
13	capability, audio streaming and raceway for future
14	video camera locations to livestream committee
15	meetings from the room;

17	(iv) All other appropriate space, areas,
18	facilities, infrastructure, furnishings and equipment
19	necessary to support the intended functions of the
20	meeting rooms.

22	(m) All necessary expenditures for the meeting
23	rooms and facilities authorized by subsection (k) of

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1	this section shall be funded from the appropriation
2	authorized in subsection (j) of this section. If the
3	state construction department and any entity procured
4	for professional services find that additional funds
5	are necessary to complete the meeting rooms and
6	facilities, and the task force recommends the
7	expenditure of additional funds, the task force may
8	include requests for an additional appropriation in
9	its interim reports.

11	Section 5. This act is effective immediately upon
12	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
13	provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
