AN ACT relating to employment of children; clarifying the penalties for violating child labor laws; clarifying an exemption; repealing a provision; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 27-6-113 is amended to read:

27-6-113. Children; penalty for violations.

(a) Any person employing any child or children in violation of the provisions of this ~~act~~chapter, or any child, subject hereto, who willfully and intentionally violates the provisions of this ~~act~~chapter, or any person who permits a violation, ~~shall be deemed is~~ guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be ~~fin~~ed ~~punished by a fine of~~ not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), ~~or imprisoned in the county jail imprisonment for~~ not more than one hundred (100) days, or both, ~~in the discretion of the court.~~

(b) Nothing in this ~~act~~chapter applies to or prevents a child under fourteen (14) years of age to be employed in a nonhazardous occupation outside of school hours by his parents, grandparents or legal guardian, or by a business owned by his parents, grandparents or legal guardian.

Section 2. W.S. 27-6-116 is repealed.
