Decreased cost in  $2^{nd}$  Notice brand renewal mailings because certified mail would no longer be required.

## Assumptions:

Brand renewals take place every odd year and the Wyoming Livestock Board (WLSB) is currently required by statute to send notices through certified mail. The amount paid for the  $2^{\rm nd}$  Notice by Certified Mail for 2019 was \$15,876.65. The bill would remove the  $2^{\rm nd}$  Notice requirement to use certified mail. The estimate presented in the table above is based on the following assumptions:

- 2021 brand renewals: 5,003
- 2021 2<sup>nd</sup> Notice Regular Mail cost, estimate: \$1,670.00
- 2021 2<sup>nd</sup> Notice Certified Mailing cost, estimate: \$15,764

\$1,674.00 regular mail costs - \$15,764 certified mail costs = (\$14,094) decrease
