Description of appropriation:

These funds would be expended to coordinate the development of statewide requirements for an integrated replacement of the revenue information system and ensure that any replacement system allows the state to take advantage of a prebuilt configurable system that is adaptable to the state's and counties' needs.

The Department of Transportation anticipates that existing personnel from the Driver's Services program and Motor Vehicle Services will be involved in this project, as well as personnel from Enterprise Technology Services. At a minimum, from the Department of Transportation, two positions will need to contribute about 20 percent of their time to the project.

Enterprise Technology Services has determined that 20 percent of 1 FTE would be appropriate to help with the initial assessment of evolving the DMV modernization options for the Department of Transportation. This time away from the FTE's normal daily duties will be required to help identify the scope of existing business processes in order to help the Department of Transportation evolve the revenue information system into more modern architecture
