Assumptions:

There are no current measures that would allow for an accurate prediction of the number of individuals sentenced pursuant to the proposed legislation. Each year of incarceration, per inmate, costs the State approximately \$44,735, including medical costs. The cost for community supervision, per offender, is approximately \$2,000 per year.
