Source of revenue increase: Application, and initial licensing fees, as well as charge of supervising physician fees.

Assumptions: The bill would authorize the Board of Medicine (Board) to issue restricted licenses to associate physicians under specific conditions. Using amounts for existing licenses, the Board estimate presented in the table above is based on the following assumptions:

- The initial license fee would be \$450
- The Board estimates 10 applications in FY2020, 20 in FY2021, and 20 in FY2020
  - o FY2020: \$450 license fee x 10 applications = \$4,500
    o FY2021: \$450 license fee x 20 applications = \$9,000
  - o FY2022: \$450 license fee x 20 applications = \$9,000
- The license renewal fee would be \$200
- The Board estimates 0 renewals in FY2020, 9 in FY2021, and 18 in FY2022
  - o FY2020: \$200 renewal fee x 0 renewals = \$0
  - o FY2021: \$200 renewal fee x 9 renewals = \$1,800
  - o FY2022: \$200 renewal fee x 18 renewals = \$3,600
- The charge of supervising physicians fee would be \$200
- The Board estimates 0 charges in FY2020, 1 in FY2021, and 2 in FY2022
  - o FY2020: \$200 supervising physicians fee x 0 charges = \$0
  - o FY2021: \$200 supervising physicians fee x 1 charges = \$200
  - o FY2022: \$200 supervising physicians fee x 2 charges = \$400
