

FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The bill may lead to a decrease in offenders sentenced to supervised probation and/or shorter periods of supervised probation. The Department of Corrections states it cannot accurately estimate the number of offenders to be sentenced or those that may be discharged as proposed in the bill. The cost of community supervision is approximately \$2,000 per year, per offender.
