

FISCAL NOTE

There will be no significant fiscal or personnel impact if the Wyoming Telecommunications Act sunset date is extended from June 30, 2019 to June 30, 2023.

By extending the sunset, the Public Service Commission (PSC) states it would continue to receive up to 3 mils on gross intrastate utility revenue as part of the Uniform Utility Assessment. This amounts to about 8.2% or approximately \$405,000 annual revenue for the PSC budget. This estimate is based on 2018 utility assessment from 2017 gross utility revenues. The PSC also notes it would continue to be administer the Wyoming Universal Services Fund and process applications and reports filed by telecommunication companies.
