FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections (DOC) also states the fiscal impact is indeterminable. The DOC states there is no current method to accurately predict the number of individuals sentenced pursuant to the proposed bill. The bill does not impose a sentence that may result in incarceration with DOC, so there would be no fiscal impact regarding incarceration costs. The cost for community supervision of is approximately \$2,000.00 per offender, per year.
