1 (a) The Wyoming water development commission may grant 2 not to exceed six million eight hundred thousand dollars 3 (\$6,800,000.00) eight million eight hundred thousand dollars 4 (\$8,800,000.00) to incorporated cities and towns, water and sewer districts and improvement and service districts in 5 Wyoming for exploration for and feasibility studies of the 6 use of underground water for municipal and rural domestic 7 8 purposes, not to exceed four hundred thousand dollars 9 (\$400,000.00) for any one (1) exploration or study. grants shall be made from revenues from water development 10 11 account I and those revenues are hereby so appropriated. Any 12 city or town, water and sewer district or service and 13 improvement district receiving a grant pursuant to this section shall provide at least twenty-five percent (25%) of 14 the cost of the exploration or study from its own funds. The 15 16 commission shall adopt rules and regulations governing 17 application procedures for the grants.

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19 **Section 7.** This act is effective immediately upon 20 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as 21 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
