

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0083

Revenue information system.

Sponsored by: Joint Transportation, Highways & Military  
Affairs Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle records; requiring the  
2 department of transportation to maintain the existing revenue  
3 information system; specifying duties of the department  
4 regarding implementation of a new system; providing an  
5 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

10

11 (a) The department of transportation in collaboration  
12 with the state chief information officer shall maintain the  
13 current revenue information system for electronic records  
14 until a replacement revenue information system is available

1 and implemented. The department of transportation in  
2 consultation with the state chief information officer shall:

3  
4 (i) Review and assess current processes before  
5 moving forward with development or implementation of a  
6 replacement revenue information system;

7  
8 (ii) Standardize county variations in operations,  
9 data quality and business processes relating to the system;

10  
11 (iii) Review and standardize current data before  
12 implementing a new system;

13  
14 (iv) Coordinate the development of statewide  
15 requirements for an integrated replacement revenue  
16 information system and ensure that any replacement system  
17 allows the state to take advantage of a prebuilt configurable  
18 system that is adaptable to the state's and counties' needs;

19  
20 (v) Support the revenue information system  
21 replacement project and promote and conduct education  
22 programs that train network users;

1           (vi) Seek funds necessary for the revenue  
2 information system maintenance and any contract as needed to  
3 carry out the responsibilities in this subsection.  
4

5           **Section 2.** There is appropriated nine hundred ten  
6 thousand dollars (\$910,000.00) from unrestricted department  
7 of transportation funds or from future cost recovery revenue  
8 for the revenue information system to the department of  
9 transportation. This appropriation shall be for the period  
10 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June  
11 30, 2020. This appropriation shall only be expended for the  
12 purpose of paying for duties as delineated in section 1 of  
13 this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this  
14 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any  
15 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining  
16 from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on  
17 June 30, 2020. This appropriation shall not be included in  
18 the department's 2021-2022 standard biennial budget request.  
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1           **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
2   completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  
3   provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
