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5 Section 2. There is appropriated nine hundred ten thousand dollars (\$910,000.00) from unrestricted department 6 of transportation funds or from future cost recovery revenue 7 8 for the revenue information system to the department of 9 transportation. This appropriation shall be for the period 10 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2020. This appropriation shall only be expended for the 11 12 purpose of paying for duties as delineated in section 1 of this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 13 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 14 15 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining 16 from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on 17 June 30, 2020. This appropriation shall not be included in

the department's 2021-2022 standard biennial budget request.

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1 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as

3 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
