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9-1-802. Election; term; qualifications; full-time;

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21 18-3-524. Appointments to fill vacancies; term.

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(a) Within twenty (20) days after the office of any county commissioner becomes vacant the remaining members of the board shall declare a vacancy to exist and immediately give notice of the vacancy in writing to the chairman of the county central committee of the political party which the member whose office is vacant represented at the time of his election under W.S. 22-6-120(a)(vii), or at the time of his appointment if not elected to office. The chairman of the county central committee shall within twenty (20) days after receipt of the notice call a meeting of the county central committee. Notice of the meeting shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county and provide that prior to the meeting any qualified person may make application directly to the county central committee to fill the vacancy. At the meeting the committee shall select three (3) persons qualified to fill the vacancy and transmit the names to the board of county commissioners. The board of county commissioners shall fill the vacancy within twenty (20) days after receiving the list from the county central 20 committee by appointing one (1) of the persons whose names 21 are submitted by the county central committee-fill the vacancy by appointment of a qualified person from those submitting 22 applications provided that: 23

(i) If the county central committee fails to select and transmit the list of three (3) names to the board of county commissioners—fill the vacancy within twenty (20) days after receipt of the notice of the vacancy, the board of county commissioners shall fill the vacancy by the appointment of any qualified person belonging to the same political party the incumbent commissioner represented at the time of his election or appointment if not elected to office;

22-18-111. Vacancies in other offices; temporary 12 appointments.

(a) Any vacancy in any other elective office in the state except representative in congress or the board of trustees of a school or community college district, shall be filled by the governing body, or as otherwise provided in this section, by appointment of a temporary successor. The person appointed shall serve until a successor for the remainder of the unexpired term is elected at the next general election and takes office on the first Monday of the following January. Provided, if a vacancy in a four (4) year term of office occurs in the term's second or subsequent years after

1 the first day for filing an application for nomination

2 pursuant to W.S. 22-5-209, no election to fill the vacancy

3 shall be held and the temporary successor appointed shall

4 serve the remainder of the unexpired term. The following

5 apply:

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7 (ii) If a vacancy occurs in a county elective 8 office, except as provided in W.S. 18-3-524, the board of 9 county commissioners of the county in which the vacancy occurs 10 shall immediately notify in writing the chairman of the county 11 central committee of the political party which the last 12 incumbent represented at the time of his election under W.S. 13 22-6-120(a)(vii), or at the time of his appointment if not elected to office. The chairman shall call a meeting of the 14 15 county central committee to be held not later than fifteen 16 (15) days after he receives twenty (20) days after receipt of 17 the notice of the vacancy. Notice of the meeting shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the county 18 19 and provide that prior to the meeting any qualified person 20 may make application directly to the county central committee to fill the vacancy. At the meeting the county central 21 22 committee shall select and transmit to the board of county 23 commissioners the names of three (3) persons qualified to

commissioners for appointment to fill the vacancy. Within

1 twenty (20) days after the publication of the vacancy in

2 office the county commissioners shall fill the vacancy by

3 appointment of one (1) person qualified to hold the office

4 from those submitting applications.÷

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6 (iii) If a vacancy occurs in the office of a member

7 of the state legislature:

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9 (A) For vacancies other than resignations, 10 the board of county commissioners of the county or counties in which the vacancy occurs shall immediately notify in 11 12 writing the chairman of the state central committee of the 13 political party which the former incumbent represented at the time of his election under W.S. 22-6-120(a)(vii), or at the 14 time of his appointment if not elected to office. 15 For 16 resignations, the governor shall notify the appropriate state 17 central committee or the appropriate board of county commissioners in accordance with W.S. 28-1-106. For all 18 19 vacancies in which the incumbent represented a political 20 party at the time of his election or appointment to the 21 office, the state central committee of the political party of the former incumbent shall notify the precinct committeemen 22 23 and committeewomen for that party for each precinct within

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1 meeting required under this subparagraph. If the precinct

2 <u>committeemen and committeewomen fail to fill any vacancy</u>

3 within twenty (20) days after receipt of the notice of the

4 vacancy, the board of county commissioners shall fill the

5 vacancy by the appointment of any qualified person belonging

6 to the same political party the former incumbent represented

7 at the time of his election or appointment if not elected to

8 <u>office</u>;

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10 (D) If the legislative district is in more 11 than one (1) county and if the circumstances require the board 12 of county commissioners to fill the vacancy, the vacancy shall be filled by the combined vote of the boards of county 13 commissioners for those counties. The vote of each county 14 15 commissioner in attendance shall be weighted so that the total 16 vote of the commissioners from each county shall be in 17 proportion to the population of the legislative district within that county. For vacancies created other than by 18 19 resignation, if the legislative district is in more than one

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(1) county, the determination of the vacancy shall be made in

accordance with this subparagraph.
