A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Hathaway scholarship program;
2 modifying the Hathaway success curriculum; requiring a study;
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1307(b)(intro), (vi)(intro),
8 (d)(intro), (vi)(intro), (e)(intro), (iii)(intro),
9 (f)(intro) and by creating a new subsection (h) is amended to
10 read:

12 **21-16-1307. Success curriculum; test standards.**

13

14 (b) The success curriculum required to qualify for
15 honor or performance scholarship eligibility under this

1 article for students graduating from high school in ~~the school~~
2 ~~year~~ 2018-2019 ~~school year and each school year thereafter~~
3 ~~through school year 2021-2022~~ shall be as follows:

5 (vi) Effective school year 2015-2016 and ~~each~~
6 ~~school year thereafter~~ ending with school year 2021-2022:

8 (d) The success curriculum required to qualify for
9 opportunity scholarship eligibility under this article for
10 students graduating from high school in ~~the school year~~
11 2010-2011 ~~school year and each school year thereafter~~ through
12 school year 2021-2022 shall be as follows:

14 (vi) Effective school year 2015-2016 and ~~each~~
15 ~~school year thereafter~~ ending with school year 2021-2022, and
16 in lieu of paragraph (v) of this subsection, one (1) of the

19 (e) The success curriculum required to qualify for
20 provisional opportunity scholarship eligibility under this
21 article for students graduating from high school in ~~the school~~
22 ~~year~~ 2010-2011 ~~school year and each school year thereafter~~
23 through school year 2021-2022 shall be the curriculum

1 required for high school graduation under W.S.
2 21-2-304(a)(iii) subject to the following:

4 (iii) Effective school year 2015-2016 and ~~each~~
5 ~~school year thereafter~~ ending with school year 2021-2022, and
6 in lieu of paragraph (ii) of this subsection, instruction in
7 one (1) of the following:

9 (f) The courses set forth as success curricula
10 requirements under this article shall be aligned with the
11 student content and performance standards established
12 pursuant to W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii). Through school year
13 2021-2022 only, the department shall by rule and regulation:

14

15 (h) The success curriculum required to qualify for a
16 honor, performance, opportunity or provisional opportunity
17 scholarship under this article for students graduating from
18 high school in school year 2022-2023 and each school year
19 thereafter shall be the curriculum required for high school
20 graduation under W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii).

21

22 **Section 2.** The joint education interim committee shall
23 conduct a study of the Hathaway scholarship program during

1 the 2019 interim. The committee shall examine program
2 components, including the success curriculum, and shall
3 sponsor any recommended legislation to change the program for
4 consideration of the legislature during the 2020 session. The
5 Wyoming department of education, state board of education and
6 Wyoming school districts shall provide assistance to the
7 committee in its study as requested by the committee.

8

9 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
10 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
11 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
