for

- 1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing that motor
- 2 vehicles are not required to display a front license plate;
- 3 specifying that the department of transportation shall only
- 4 issue one (1) license plate for motor vehicles; making
- 5 conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 31-2-204(a), 31-2-212, 31-2-213(b) and
- 10 (h)(viii), 31-2-215(a) and (c), 31-2-216(a), 31-2-217(a),
- 31-2-223(c), 31-2-230(h), 31-2-231(f), 31-3-102(a)(vi)(A)
- 12 through (C) and 31-4-101(a)(i) through (iii) are amended to

1 31-2-204. Issuance of certificates of registration and 2 license plates by county; form. 3 4 (a) Upon receipt of an approved application and payment 5 of fees the county treasurer shall issue to the applicant a certificate of registration conforming with the facts set 6 forth in the application together with one (1) license plate 7 8 or validation sticker for motorcycles, multipurpose vehicles, 9 trailers, including house trailers, and all vehicles. 10 operated with dealer license plates and two (2) license plates 11 or proper validation stickers for any other vehicle. A copy 12 of the certificate of registration shall be carried at all times in the motor vehicle for which it is valid and shall be 13 14 displayed upon demand of any peace officer. 15 16 31-2-212. Loss, mutilation ordestruction οf registration, plates or validation stickers. 17 18 19 Upon loss, mutilation or destruction of a certificate of 20 registration, license plate, or validation sticker the owner 21 of a vehicle may obtain a duplicate certificate of 22 registration, new license plates plate or validation stickers 23 sticker from any county treasurer or the department if the

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1 vehicle was registered or plates or stickers were the plate 2 or sticker was issued by the department upon application 3 showing the loss, mutilation or destruction, return of 4 mutilated plates or stickers plate or sticker and payment of 5 the duplicate registration, plate or sticker fee. For those vehicles registered under the provisions of W.S. 31-2-213(h) 6 or 31-2-215 through 31-2-223, a replacement duplicate license 7 8 plates plate may be obtained upon application with the county 9 treasurer from which the original plates were plate was 10 purchased or the department if applicable, accompanied by 11 fees as provided by W.S. 31-3-102(a)(vi)(C). Duplicate A 12 duplicate license plate plate obtained under this section to 13 replace a lost or stolen plates plate shall not be displayed on the vehicle until the validation stickers sticker on the 14 15 lost or stolen plates have plate has expired. Upon loss, 16 mutilation or destruction of a dealer plate or validation 17 sticker the dealer may obtain a replacement dealer plate or validation sticker from the county treasurer from which he 18 19 purchased the original plate in the same manner as the owner 20 of a vehicle and upon payment of the appropriate fee under 21 W.S. 31-3-102(a)(vi). Obtaining a replacement plate is not plate 22 the purchase of an additional under W.S. 23 31-16-125(b)(i). Upon application for a new license plates

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1 <u>plate</u> or <u>stickers sticker</u> the county treasurer shall notify

2 the department and the county sheriff as soon as possible of

3 the loss, mutilation or destruction. The department shall

4 notify the appropriate law enforcement agencies of any loss,

5 mutilation or destruction of a license plates or stickers

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12 (b) The department may issue license plates, except

13 dealer and antique motor vehicle license plates, which shall

14 be valid for not more than eight (8) years if \underline{an} annual

16 of the license plate with the month and year of expiration

17 clearly visible. Department authorized license plates and

18 annual stickers shall be of colors that are readily

19 distinguishable from the previous year.

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21 (h) Effective January 1, 1993, any person eligible for

22 a special placard under subsection (c) of this section may

23 apply to the county treasurer for special license plates for

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1 a motor vehicle owned by that person. Special license plates

2 shall not be issued to any person who is eligible only for a

3 temporary removable windshield placard under subsection (g)

4 of this section. Special plates issued under this subsection

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7 (viii) The county treasurer shall issue a set of

8 plates license plate for each vehicle and a special license

9 plate for each motorcycle registered to a qualified applicant

10 under this subsection upon payment of required fees.

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12 31-2-215. Disabled veteran's license plates.

- 14 (a) A disabled veteran who receives fifty percent (50%)
- 15 or more service connected disability compensation from the
- 16 United States department of veteran's affairs and who is a
- 17 resident at the time of initial application and renewal
- 18 application under subsection (b) of this section, may apply
- 19 for distinctive license plates for a passenger car, pickup
- 20 truck, motorcycle or multipurpose vehicle owned or leased by
- 21 him upon registration of the vehicle. These license plates
- 22 shall be displayed upon the vehicle for which they are issued.
- 23 A disabled veteran may purchase one (1) additional pair of

1 license plate plate as provided in this section for either

2 a motorcycle or a multipurpose vehicle upon payment of regular

3 fees provided in this article. The license plates shall bear

4 a distinctive symbol or letters identifying the registrant as

5 a disabled veteran. The department shall prescribe the symbol

6 or letters which shall not include arabic numerals

7 designating the county.

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9 (c) The county treasurer shall only issue one (1) pair

10 of license plates plate annually that are is exempt as

11 provided by W.S. 31-3-101(a)(xv) to each applicant under this

12 section.

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14 31-2-216. Special plates; former prisoners of war.

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16 (a) The county treasurer shall issue one (1) set of

17 special license plates plate for either a passenger car, truck

18 or motor home owned or leased by a former prisoner of war in

19 accordance with this section for the year 1988 and thereafter.

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21 31-2-217. Special plates; Pearl Harbor survivors;

22 national guard members; armed forces veterans; purple heart

23 recipients.

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2 The county treasurer shall issue one (1) set of 3 special license plates plate to each applicant for either a 4 passenger car, truck, motorcycle, handicapped motorcycle or motor home owned or leased by a survivor of Pearl Harbor, a 5 6 member of the Wyoming army or air national guard a purple heart recipient or honorably discharged veteran of the United 7 8 States armed forces in accordance with this section for the 9 year 1990 and thereafter. For the year 1993 and thereafter, 10 the county treasurer shall issue one (1) set of special license plate plate to each applicant for either a passenger 11 12 car, truck, motorcycle, handicapped motorcycle or motor home 13 owned by a purple heart recipient. These license plates shall 14 be displayed upon the vehicle for which they are issued.

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16 31-2-223. Antique motor vehicles.

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(c) Upon receipt of an approved application and payment of fees the vehicle shall be registered and a license plates plate issued therefor. The registration expires upon transfer of ownership of the vehicle. Notwithstanding W.S. 31 2 205(a)(i)(A), a license plate shall only be required to

2	were originally manufactured to have one (1) license plate.
