A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; defining sexual
2 intrusion to include female genital mutilation; specifying
3 that transporting a minor for the purpose of female genital
4 mutilation is a crime; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-301(a)(vii)(A) and (B) and by
9 creating a new subparagraph (C), 6-2-702(a)(ii), (iii) and by
10 creating a new paragraph (iv) and 6-2-703(a) by creating a
11 new paragraph (iv) are amended to read:

13 **6-2-301. Definitions.**

15 (a) As used in this article:

(vii) "Sexual intrusion" means:

(A) Any intrusion, however slight, by any object or any part of a person's body, except the mouth, tongue or penis, into the genital or anal opening of another person's body if that sexual intrusion can reasonably be construed as being for the purposes of sexual arousal, gratification or abuse;~~or~~

(B) Sexual intercourse, cunnilingus, fellatio, analingus or anal intercourse with or without emission;~~or~~ or

(C) When performed on a minor, the partial or total removal of the clitoris, prepuce, labia minora, with or without excision of the labia major, the narrowing of the vaginal opening through the creation of a covering seal formed by cutting and repositioning the inner or outer labia, with or without removal of the clitoris, or any harmful procedure to the genitalia, including pricking, piercing, incising, scraping or cauterizing. "Sexual intrusion" under this subparagraph does not include procedures performed by a

1 licensed health care provider that are proven to be medically
2 necessary due to a medically recognized condition.

4 **6-2-702. Human trafficking in the first degree;**
5 **penalty.**

7 (a) A person is guilty of human trafficking in the first
8 degree when the person intentionally or knowingly recruits,
9 transports, transfers, harbors, receives, provides, obtains,
10 isolates, maintains or entices an individual for the purpose
11 of:

13 (ii) Sexual servitude in violation of W.S.
14 6-2-705; ~~or~~

16 (iii) Sexual servitude of a minor in violation of
17 W.S. 6-2-706; ~~or~~ or

19 (iv) Causing sexual intrusion as defined in
20 W.S. 6-2-301(a)(vii)(C) to be performed.

22 **6-2-703. Human trafficking in the second degree;**
23 **penalty.**

2 (a) A person is guilty of human trafficking in the
3 second degree when the person recklessly recruits,
4 transports, transfers, harbors, receives, provides, obtains,
5 isolates, maintains or entices an individual for the purpose
6 of:

8 (iv) Causing sexual intrusion as defined in
9 W.S. 6-2-301(a)(vii)(C) to be performed.

10

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as
13 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
